## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

For the week of November 26, 2023

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- What is one of the most meaningful/fulfilling ways that you have served/ministered to a person/group?
- What is one of the most odd "disclaimers" that you've seen in a form of advertising?
- The 'goal' of a New Testament church is to help others know Jesus and to "walk worthy." Read I Thessalonians 2:12 and Ephesians 4:1-3 and talk about what it means to "walk worthy."
- Read Joshua 1:8, Hebrews 4:12, and Romans 10:17 and talk about some meaningful ways that you have experienced the truth in these passages.
- Read I Thessalonians 2:14-18, Il Timothy 3:12, and Romans 8:18 and describe a Biblical view of suffering.
- Read Hebrews 10:25 and talk about the difference(s) between "attending" (not forsaking) and "exhorting."
- What would it look like for you to be "all the way in" at Grace (or in your walk with Jesus)?
- Take some time together to pray together.
