DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

For the week of November 5, 2023

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- What is one of the most unusual/unbelievable things that has happened in your life?
- What is something that you 'know how to do' very well/proficiently?
- The people of Israel found themselves in a place where they didn't know what to do in Exodus 12-15. Talk about a time in your life when you didn't know what to do.
- Read Exodus 14:11-12 and talk about where these thoughts came from and where they had the potential to lead them. Then, talk about some irrational thoughts that you have been tempted to entertain during difficult times of life
- What does it look like to practically live out II Corinthians 10:5?
- What does Exodus 13:17 teach about God's sovereignty in the storms of life? What does it look like to practically live out the belief that God is in control and that He allows things for a reason? (see Ecclesiastes 7:13-14)
- After reading Exodus 14:13-15, Josh said, "When you don't know what to do, do what you know to do." In those tough times, which is harder for you: 'standing still' or 'going forward?'
- Talk about the ways that God had shown Himself powerful and given gifts to the Israelites, then discuss why it is so easy to do what they did and forget about God's provision and power during difficult times.
- Take some time to pray together.
