DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

For the week of December 3, 2023

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- Who is the most impatient person you know?
- What is something for which you can't stand "waiting?"
- Read Luke 1:8-13 and talk about what it must have been like to be in Zachariah's position in this story.
- Zachariah's life was one spent "waiting." Talk about some of the more difficult times of "waiting" in our lives.
- Read Luke 1:19-20. What did Zachariah do that caused him to not be able to talk? How does believing the Word of God change the way we wait? (and vice versa)
- Talk about this statement, "Promises produce patience."
- After Gabriel left, there were a lot of things that Zachariah did not know. Josh called this "ignorant patience." Talk about what it means to 'embrace this ignorance' in our times of waiting and how it impacts our waiting.
- Luke 1:58-80 is full of rejoicing. Talk about what it looks like to "rejoice worshipfully" in times of waiting and after the waiting is over.
- Take some time together to pray together.
