- What does it mean to be "crucified with Christ" or to "die to self"?
- What are some ways that you could "die to self" or "crucify the flesh" in your life?
- What are some DAILY practices that could help you in this area?
- Which category do you find yourself in:
- 1. The person who has never believed the Gospel. (Struggles to believe)
- 2. The person who is still living for this world. (Struggles to deny themselves)
- 3. The person who has a hard time recognizing God's love. (Struggles to trust)
- Explain your answer. (It can be more than one.)
- Ephesians 3:14-21 // Romans 8:31-39
- How does knowing God's love for you change the way that you live your life?
- "New life is found exclusively in Jesus."
- What are the things of this world (whether good or bad) that you seek to find life in?
