For the week of Jan 7 2024

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- What is one of the funniest things you've ever seen on a t-shirt?
- On Sunday, Andrew talked about changing his mind about health and exercise. What's something you've changed your mind about recently?
- Read 2 Corinthians 5:17. Discuss some of the ways that a Christian's Gospel lens should make them new in the way they think?
- We learned that we are called to unity. What are some ways Christians can practically pursue unity? What are some ways Satan sows division?
- Why do you think unity at times seems so difficult, and how do we sometimes complicate it?
- We are also called to unanimity (agreement on core beliefs). Read John 1:14. Why does both WHAT we believe and HOW we believe it matter?
- We are called to unconditional trust. Would you be willing to share a difficult thing that you've chosen to trust God with even when you didn't understand?
- Read Galatians 2:20. How can trusting God with what you don't understand, whether in your own life or in the world, change you into a better person and follower of Jesus?
- Read Ephesians 1:10-11. How does having a big picture acknowledgement of God at work in the world change everything for the believer?
- Who do you know in need of the peace of God you have through Christ?
- Take some time to pray together. Pray for the people just mentioned who need to come to faith.
