## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

For the week of February 4, 2024

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- The Super Bowl is this weekend. What is one snack that you cannot live without and one snack that you'd banish from existence?
- What is something that you've experienced in life that has caused you to either walk and/or act differently? (this can be literal/figurative or funny/serious)
- Read Ephesians 4:17 and talk about what comes to mind when you think of "walking like other Gentiles."
- Read Ephesians 4:17-19 and talk about each of the descriptions of the way that "Gentiles" walk. Try to give practical, real-life examples.
- Re-read that passage and talk about how believers can fall into the trap
  of doing each of these things. Try to give practical, real-life examples.
- Read Ephesians 4:20-22. Talk about practical ways to "put off the old man."
- What does it look like to be "renewed?" (See Ephesians 4:23 and Colossians 3:10)
- What does it look like to "put on the new man?" (See Ephesians 4:24 and Romans 13:13-14)
- Talk about this phrase, "It's not so much about what you turn FROM, as much as it is about what you turn TO."
- Take some time together to pray together.
