DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

For the week of February 25, 2024

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- What's the best piece of advice you've ever been given?
- What's the worst piece of advice you've ever been given?
- We briefly talked about Ephesians 4:28. Identify the thing that needs put off, put on, and the truth that renews our minds in this verse.
- Work gives an opportunity to minister to those in need. Talk about how this mindset changes the way we work.
- Read Ephesians 4:29 and James 3:8-12. Create a list of things that could be considered "corrupt communication."
- Look back at your list of "corrupt communication" and talk about the "Why?" What is it that motivates us to communicate in these ways?
- Ephesians 4:29 tells us to "put on...that which is good." This kind of communication either "edifies" or "ministers." Talk about things that others that have said to you that "edified" or "ministered" to you.
- Read Proverbs 18:21 and talk about how you have seen the truth of this verse in your life, or in the lives of others.
- On a scale of 1-10 (1 being "death" and 10 being "life), where would you put your own words? What keeps you from being closer to 10?
- How does Ephesians 4:30 tie in with 4:29? Does Luke 6:45 give us additional insight into this?
- Is there someone that you can intentionally speak words of life into?
 What can you say to them that would edify and/or minister to them?
- Take some time to pray together.
