

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

For the week of March 10, 2023

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to “break the ice” and get people talking)

- Who is the most humble person you have ever known? What is it about this person that brought them to mind?
- What is the most menial, humble task that you’ve ever been given?
- Read John 13:1-8 and talk about why Peter would not have wanted Jesus to wash his feet.
- Jesus explains why he washed their feet in John 13:15. Talk about the mindset a person must have to literally wash another person’s feet. Then, discuss how we should carry that mindset into our service of others.
- What are some examples of ways (other than foot washing) we can serve with these goals in mind?
- Think about a time you’ve had your feet washed (either physically or metaphorically). What was that experience like for you? Be specific.
- How does seeing Jesus’ act of service through the lens of what He knew about Himself and His disciples give this story a greater impact? What does that mean for how you should see Jesus treating you and you serving others?
- Read John 13:17. What is it about “washing feet” that brings “happiness?”
- What is one practical thing you can do this week to follow Jesus’ example of humble service?
- Take some time to pray together.
