## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

For the week of March 17, 2024

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- On Sunday, we talked about getting caught off guard by things. What is something funny or serious that has caught you off guard recently?
- Can you share a time when you have felt an urgent compelling to help do something, say something, or give something to someone?
- Read Acts 1:8 and 2 Timothy 1:7. What does the Holy Spirit give to the believer, and for what purpose? How can this help us have the proper mindset for divine appointments.
- Read I Peter 3:15. Why do you think the first part of this verse is so important to the second part of the verse?
- What are some of the real-life things that can often get in the way of us seeing divine appointments for what they are in our day-to-day lives?
- How have you personally (or someone you know) given up something sacrificially at the drop of a hat to be Jesus to someone else in need?
- Read 2 Corinthians 5:18-20. Once we have become a witness to the power of the cross (reconciled to God), what has God called us to do or be?
- We talked about Billy Graham coming to faith through a chain of divine appointments. Share your story of different people God used directly or indirectly to bring you to faith in Christ.
- Who is someone God has put on your heart through talking about this topic of the unexpected cross and divine appointments?
- Take some time to pray together.
