

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

For the week of May 12, 2024

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to “break the ice” and get people talking)

- Share a funny (or heartwarming) story about your mother.
- What is something your mother did that went ‘unnoticed’ while you were a child...but now you can clearly see how meaningful it was.
- Read Exodus 17:8-13. As you think through this story (and other stories in the Bible), how might Hur go ‘unnoticed?’
- It may have been tempting for Hur to compare himself with Moses and Joshua and to see himself as been less important/valuable. Have you ever wrestled with these kinds of thoughts?
- In the sermon, what did you learn from the ‘drill’ where the crowd cheered the first time, and then they didn’t cheer the second time? How can we cultivate a mindset of serving God in our daily tasks, especially when they seem mundane or unappreciated?
- Hur’s grandson, Bezaleel, was chosen to help build the tabernacle. Discuss the idea that our actions have the power to move others toward their destinies. Can you think of examples from your own life (or others’) where this has been true?
- When you are feeling ‘unnoticed’ or ‘unappreciated,’ what are some things that have been helpful? What ‘takeaways’ from the story of Hur can be helpful in the future?
- Take some time to pray together.
